The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by President Carolyn Else. The Minutes for the June 15th meeting were motioned for approval and seconded by board members.

The financial report was given by Carol Burton for June 2016: Operating account is \$13,144.42, insurance reserve is \$6,757.62, money market account is \$103,248.19 and the petty cash account has \$300.00.

Maintenance and Repair

Topics reviewed:

- Retaining wall on east side of entrance was re-installed correctly; new fence panels have been installed as well,
- Remainder of south fence will need replacing eventually,
- Grab handles beside steps on various units may be installed at owners' expense, (flyer sent out explaining whom to contact),
- Install exterior faucet for club house,
- East fence near unit 4A needs attention (pushed out by loose gravel),
- Asphalt cracks in pavement need to be addressed later this summer,
- Williamswood sign lighting needs to be installed; solar powered light to be investigated,
- Vinyl siding washing continues; sidewalks will be washed as needed,
- Drainage in area between 13A and 11B to be addressed in the near future,
- Roof truss deflection issue creating some interior cracks. Cosmetic repair to be tried on worst cases initially (6B),
- The painting of directional signs including a large **10 MPH** on roadway to be done by Eagle Asphalt at a cost of \$475,
- Faux cameras at entrance to be re-installed,

Bob Sauve will be able to address most of the above.

Landscaping

Topics reviewed:

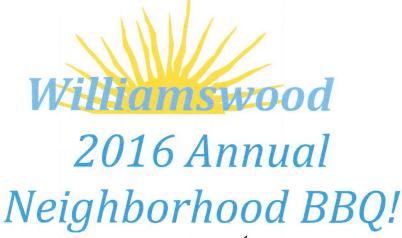
- Arborist to prune and feed approximately 30 trees Aug. 1-3. Estimated cost: \$4,536. One large tree to be removed next to 2B, cost of: \$500. Trees in private patio areas are owner's responsibility,
- Some dead shrubs behind building 6 may need to be removed
- It was noted that some common area flower beds need some weeding.

New Business

- Discussed the possibility of a presentation by Pierce Co. officials regarding emergency preparedness information. Carol Burton to coordinate with Peg Greer in arranging.
- New residents have moved into 13A.
- New resident's information packets/web-site development, to be looked into by board and Susan Fish.
- Discussed need for exterior trim painting on some units.
